



The goal of the **Montana READS (CLSD) Grant** is to elevate literacy achievement for all K-12 students by using evidence-based solutions and strengthening educator training around scientifically based reading instruction.

Grant Goals

- 1. Build the capacity of districts serving the highest percentage of disadvantaged students to accelerate their literacy outcomes.
- 2. Increase the number of disadvantaged students who have access to effective educators prepared to implement and sustain scientifically based reading instruction.
- 3. Strengthen systems to provide and implement high-quality evidence-based literacy instruction.
